
#### **Award Guidelines**

- A. Purpose: The CEA Board of Governors has established the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award for distinguished service in the areas of community service, education, or human and civil rights which has been rendered at the local, state or national level.
- B. Award: The presentation of a plaque will be made by the President of the Columbus Education Association at the Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award Dinner.
- C. Eligibility: Any individual may be nominated for this award except current employees of Columbus City Schools. There shall be no time limit placed upon the period within which specific achievements have been accomplished. The criteria for selecting an award winner, however, demands that such contributions be of sufficient quality and importance as to cause the award to be viewed with respect and high esteem.
- D. Nominations: Nominations will be accepted from community members, including students, parents, businesspersons, teachers and public officials. Nominations must be submitted to the CEA Office by 4:30 p.m., Friday, December 2, 2022, and should be mailed or faxed to:
