Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award

The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Humanitarian Award, presented by the Columbus Education Association, is the oldest award of its kind in Central Ohio. This is the 45th Anniversary of this award being presented on behalf of the teachers of Columbus City Schools. Our teachers are proud to commemorate Dr. King's life and to salute annually someone who has worked to keep his dream alive.

To nominate someone, read the guidelines below and complete the attached nomination form. Supportive documents or attachments are permitted.

The annual banquet will be held on Thursday, January 15, 2026, prior to the observance of the Dr. King national holiday. Anyone wishing to attend may call CEA for tickets.

Award Guidelines

- **A. Purpose:** The CEA Board of Governors has established the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award for distinguished service in the areas of community service, education or human and civil rights which has been rendered at the local, state or national level.
- **B.** Award: The presentation of a plaque will be made by the President of the Columbus Education Association at the Annual Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Award Banquet.
- C. Eligibility: Any individual may be nominated for this award except current employees of Columbus City Schools. There shall be no time limit placed upon the period within which specific achievements have been accomplished. The criteria for selecting an award winner, however, demands that such contributions be of sufficient quality and import as to cause the award to be viewed with respect and high esteem.
- **D.** Nominations: Nominations will be accepted from community members, including students, parents, business-persons, teachers and public officials. Nominations must be submitted to the CEA Office by 4:30 p.m., Friday, December 5, 2025, and should be sent to:
